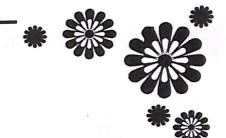
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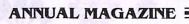




## व्याभी भिजान









### বিহু পৰম্পৰাত বৈজ্ঞানিক ভিত্তি

বিহু পদটোৰ উৎপত্তি সম্পৰ্কত নানা পণ্ডিতৰ নানা মত দেখা যায়। কিছুমান পণ্ডিতৰ মতে সংস্কৃত 'বিষুবৎ বা বিষুৱণ' পদৰ পৰা 'বিষু', 'বিহু' আদি অভিধানবোৰৰ জন্ম হয়। বিষু বা বিহু পদটোৰ প্ৰচলন ভাৰতৰ আন আন অঞ্চলতো বৰ্তমান। দক্ষিণ ভাৰতৰ নায়াৰসকলে নৱবৰ্ষৰ উৎসৱ পালন কৰে আৰু এই উৎসৱৰ নামো বিষু বা Vishu' কালিৰাম মেধিয়ে উল্লেখ কৰিছে কৰ্কটক্ৰান্তি আৰু মকৰক্ৰান্তিৰ মাজত গতি কৰোঁতে সূৰ্যই বিষুৱক স্পৰ্শ কৰে। আহাৰৰ শেষত এবাৰ, চ'তৰ শেষৰ আনবাৰ, আহিনৰ শেষত সূৰ্যই কৰ্কটক্ৰান্তি স্পৰ্শ কৰে। তাৰপৰা ক্ৰমে দক্ষিণফালে গতি কৰি দক্ষিণায়ন আৰম্ভ হয়। আহিনৰ শেষত বিষুৱৰ ওপৰ পায়। তাৰ পাছত ক্ৰমশঃ আহি পুহৰ শেষৰ দক্ষিণায়নৰ শেষ বিন্দু মকৰক্ৰান্তি স্পৰ্শ কৰে। ইয়াৰ পৰা উত্তৰায়ণ আৰম্ভ হয়। আৰু চ'তৰ শেষত সূৰ্য গৈ পুনঃ বিষুৱক স্পৰ্শ কৰে। এইবোৰ কথাৰ সম্বন্ধ থকা কাৰণে এই সময়ৰ উৎসৱক 'বিহু' বোলা হয়। বসন্তকানীন বিহু উৎসৱ ব'হাগ বিহু, ৰঙালী বিহু,

বৌসাগু, বায়খু, বিসু,, বুসু, আলি-আই-লিগাং, চ'ত সংক্রান্তি আদি বিভিন্ন নামেৰে অসমৰ জাতি-জনজাতি উভয়ৰে মাজত প্রচলিত। বসন্তকালীন উৎসৱৰ পৰম্পৰীণ মুখ্য উদ্দেশ্য প্রজনন মাদু সম্পাদন।

বিহু সৃষ্টিৰ উৎসৱ। কাৰণ চ'ত-ব'হাগ মাহত প্রকৃতিয়ে নতুন ৰূপ ধাৰণ কৰে মৌচুমীৰ আৰম্ভণিত। বায়ু, পানী আৰু মাটিৰ সংশ্রৱত ভূমি উর্বৰা হয়। উর্বৰা ভূমিত লহপহকৈ শস্য গজে। এই কথা মানৱ জীৱনৰ ক্ষেত্রটো খাটে। কিয়নো শস্য আৰু সন্তানৰ মাজত বিশেষ পার্থক্য নাই। বিহু উৎসৱৰ যি পৰম্পৰা, যি গীত-মাত নৃত্য ই অকল উৎসৱৰে অংগ নহয় মানুহৰ লগত আৰু সৃষ্টিৰ লগত ইয়াৰ সম্পর্ক অতি গভীৰ। আমি নভবা এটি বিহুগীতৰ মাজতো এহাতে বৈজ্ঞানিক ভিত্তি আৰু মানুহৰ কাৰণে সুমংগল সোমাই আছে তাকে ভাবিলে আচৰিত হ'ব লাগে। বিহুগীতটোত আছে—

এটা বাতিত নহৰু, এটা বাতিত পনৰু, এটা বাতিত খুতুৰা শাক। মূৰৰ চুলি ছিঙি আশীৰ্বাদ কৰিছোঁ, ৰাইজ মোৰ কুশলে থাক।

—এই বিহুগীতফাকি বিহুগীতেই নহয় ই জীৱনক সুন্দৰ

আৰু সৃষ্টিৰ কৰি ৰখাৰো বিধান। কিয়নো শীত গৈ বসন্ত গ্ৰীত্ম অহাৰ লগে লগে মানুহৰ শৰীৰৰ উষণ্ডতাৰ পৰিবৰ্তন হয়। শীতল পৰিবেশৰ পৰা উত্ম পৰিবেশলৈ আহোঁতে এই সময়খিনিত মানুহক বায়ুৰোগ, পিত্তৰোগ আদিয়ে আগুৰি ধৰে। বিহুগীতে কোৱা নহৰু, পনৰু, খুতুৰা শাক আদি





একেলগে খালে মানুহৰ বায়ুৰোগৰ উপশম হয়, নিবৃত্তি হয়।
নহৰুয়ে যকৃতৰ সুস্থতা আনি এই সময়ত হোৱা খোৱা-লোৱাৰ
অনিচ্ছা দূৰ কৰে। তেনেকৈ শাক মানুহৰ তেজ বৰ্ধক। সেইবাবেই
এনে বিহুগীতেৰে বিহুৱাসকলে মানুহক কাতৰ অনুৰোধ কৰিছে
এই খাদ্য খাই দীৰ্ঘায়ু আৰু সু-স্বাস্থ্যৰ গৰাকী হ'বলৈ।

এই ছেগতে বিহুৰ আন এটা প্ৰম্পৰা সাত শাকীৰ কথা নকৈ নোৱাৰিলো। সাতশাকী সাত বিহুৰ দিনাখন মানুহে খোৱাৰ পৰম্পৰা আছে। সাতবিহুৰ দিনাখন সাতবিধ শাকৰ লগতে কল পচলা আৰু তিতভেকুৰী খোৱাটো বিহুৰ প্ৰম্পৰা। কল পচলাই পেটৰ ভিতৰত থকা গৰম ভাৱ নিৱাৰণ কৰি শৰীৰক সুস্থ কৰাত সহায় কৰে। আনহাতে তিতভেকুৰী পিত্ত আৰু কৃমি নাশক। সেয়েহে হয়তো অসমীয়া লোকে প্ৰম্পৰাত তিতভেকুৰী দেখিলেই খোৱাৰে নিয়ম আজিও বৰ্তমান হৈ আছে। সেই বাবেই ক'বলৈ মন গৈছে য়ে অসমীয়া লোক-প্ৰম্পৰা বা বিহু প্ৰম্পৰা হাঁহি-তামচাৰে ভাগৰ জুৰোৱা গান নহয় ই জীৱনক দীৰ্ঘায়ু কৰাৰ এটা সুন্দৰ উপাদান বা ইয়াত বৈজ্ঞানিক ভিত্তিৰো পৰিপূৰ্ণতা আছে।

সাত বিহুৰ প্ৰথমদিনা গৰু বিহু। সেইদিনা গৰুৰ গা ধুৱাই লাওঁ-বেঙেনা খুৱাই, গধূলি গোহালিৰ সন্মুখত ধোঁৱা দি ভৰি ধুৱাই বিছনিৰে বিচি নতুন পঘাৰূপী বিহুৱান দিয়ে। ই মূলত গৰু পূজা। কৃষিৰ লগত জড়িত গৰুকো বিহুৱান দি পূজা কৰি সাজু কৰি লয় কৃষিৰ বাবে। এই ব'হাগতে বহু ঠাইত ভঠেলি উৎসৱ পালন কৰা হয়। ই মূলতে বাঁহ বা গছ পূজা। অসমীয়া সমাজৰ লোক-পৰম্পৰাত গছ-গছনি, জীৱ-জন্তু আদিক এনেদৰে পূজা-অৰ্চনা কৰা, মৰম-চেনেহ কৰা পৰস্পৰা অতীতৰে পৰা চলি আহিছে। এই পৰম্পৰাই আমাক ইয়াকে সোঁৱৰাই দিব খুজিছে যে গছ-গচনি, জীৱ-জন্তু, মাটি-পানী এই বিশ্ব সমূহ সৃষ্টিকে আমি শ্রেষ্ঠ জীৱ হিচাপে মৰম-চেনেহ, পূজা-অর্চনাৰে নিজৰ দৰে বা সমভাৱে জীয়াই ৰাখিবলৈ চেষ্টা নকৰো তেনেহ'লে এই সেউজীয়া পথিৱীত অঘটন হ'ব। তেতিয়াই আমাৰ বিহুৰ উদ্দেশ্যত বিঘ্নিত হ'ব। মহাপুৰুষ শঙ্কৰদেৱেও পৃথিৱীৰ তৰু-তৃণ, জীৱ-জন্তুক সমজ্ঞান কৰাৰ কথা কৈ গৈছে এনেদৰে— "কুকুৰ শৃগাল গৰ্দভৰো আত্মা ৰাম জানিয়া সবাকো পৰি কৰিবা প্ৰণাম।" অসমীয়া লোক-পৰম্পৰাৰ মান অতি উচ্চ। প্ৰকৃতিক আপোন কৰি লোৱা স্বভাৱ অসমীয়াৰ কোনোবা অতীজৰ পৰাই প্ৰচলিত। এটা বিহুগীতত আছে—

বাঁহৰ তলে তলে বাঁহীটি বজালো শাহু আয়ে শুনকহি বুলি, শাহু আয়ে শুনিলে, মিচিকিয়াই হাঁহিলে জোঁৱাই ধেমেলীয়া বুলি।

অসমীয়া সমাজৰ ঘৰৰ পিছফালে গছ-গছনি পূৰ্ণ বাৰী। ঘৰৰ সন্মুখ সুগন্ধি গছৰ শাৰী তাতে জোঁৱায়ে বাঁহী বজোৱা কথাৰ পৰাই গছ-গছনি আৰু তৰু-তৃণ অসমীয়া সমাজৰ যে এৰাব নোৱাৰা আপোন সম্পদ তাকেহে বুজাইছে, তাক কোৱাৰ প্ৰয়োজন নাই।

বিহুই কোনো জাতি-ধৰ্ম নামানে। আগৰ সমাজত গছৰ তলে তলে বিহু গাইছিল। ডেকা-গাবৰুৱে আৰু বিহুৱা দলে ৰাইজৰ ঘৰে ঘৰে বিহু গাই আশীৰ্বাদ দিছিল ৰাইজ কুশলে থাকিবলৈ, জীয়াই থাকিবলৈ, আজিৰ বিহু মঞ্চত হয়। সমাজ পাতি বিহু কৰে, মানুহে ঘৰে ঘৰে বন্ধুজনক নিমন্ত্ৰণ কৰি সাদৰ-সম্ভাষণেৰে বিহুৱান যাচে, খুৱাই-বুৱাই আদৰ কৰে। ডাঙৰক সৰুৱে প্ৰণাম কৰে আৰু ডাঙৰে সৰুক আশীৰ্বাদ দিয়ে। এইবোৰ পৰস্পৰাৰইও আমাক জাতি-বৰ্ণ নিবিচাৰি মিলা-প্ৰীতিৰে বাস কৰি সুন্দৰ সৃষ্টিৰ পাতনি মেলিবলৈ কৈ নিদিয়েনে। তেন্তে আমি কিয় পাহৰি যাওঁ অতীজৰ বিহুৰ পৰম্পূৰা। পাহৰা কথাটো এই কাৰণে উল্লেখ কৰিছো যে আজৰি সমাজত ইজনে সিজনক সন্দেহ কৰে, ভয় কৰে, আনকি কেতিয়াবা দুটা সম্প্ৰদায়ৰ মাজত বিভেদো সৃষ্টি হ'ব খোজে। বিহুৱে নতুন আশা উদ্দীপনাৰে ভয়, সন্দেহ আঁতৰ কৰি আৰু সমাজক ঐক্যতাৰে আগবঢ়াই নিয়ক। সদৌ শেষত ক'ব পাৰি যে, বিহু শব্দটোৰ লগত অসমীয়া মানুহক নতুনকৈ' চিনাকি কৰি দিয়াৰ প্ৰয়োজন নাই। অসমীয়াৰ হাড়ে-হিমজুৱে সোমাই থকা বিহু জাতীয় উৎসৱে আমাৰ মাজলৈ কঢ়িয়াই আনে বিভিন্ন জাতি-জনজাতিৰ মাজত একতাৰ এনাজৰী আৰু শুভ কামনাৰ লগতে আশিস নিৰ্মালী। বিহুক অসমীয়াৰ জাতীয় উৎসৱ আৰু সংস্কৃতিৰ বাহক বুলিয়েই আমি ধৰি লওঁ। যদিও বিহু পৰম্পৰাৰ অন্তৰালত একো একোটা বৈজ্ঞানিক ভিত্তি থকা কথাটোও নুই কৰিব নোৱাৰি।

### টিউচন বা গৃহশিক্ষা

#### খনীন্দ্র ডেকা স্নাতক দ্বিতীয় ষান্মাসিক

কলেজ ছুটীৰ পিছত ঘৰলৈ আহি কিতাপৰ বোজা টেবুলত থৈ দৌৰা-দৌৰিকৈ ভাতকেইটা খাই পুনৰ কান্ধত বেগ, হাতত মোবাইল ফোন লৈ টিউচনলৈ যোৱা স্কুলীয়া তথা কলেজীয়া ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীৰ এক জনপ্ৰিয় বিষয় হৈ পৰিছে। শিশুসকলে অ, আ, ক, খ ৰ লগত পৰিচিত হোৱাৰ দিনাৰে পৰা প্ৰায়ভাগ অভিভাৱকে গৃহ শিক্ষকৰ হাতত সন্তানক এৰি দি নিজৰ কৰ্তব্য সমাধান কৰে। পুৱা শুই উঠাৰ পিছত আৰম্ভ হয় টিউচন, তাৰ পিছত মহাবিদ্যালয়-বিদ্যালয়ৰ গধুৰ বোজা, আকৌ আহিয়েই নিশালৈকে দুই-তিনিটা টিউচন। মুকলি আকাশৰ তলত প্ৰকৃতিৰ শস্য-শ্যামলা পথাৰত স্বাধীন মনেৰে খেলিবলৈ আজিৰ ছাত্ৰসকলে সময় নোপোৱা হৈছে। সৰুৰে পৰা টিউচন নিৰ্ভৰ ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীয়ে ভৱিষ্যতে সাধাৰন সমস্যাকো সমাধান কৰিব নোৱাৰা হয়।

আজিৰ ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীসকলে মনত ৰখা উচিত, 'লো যিমানে কঠিন নহওক কিয় তাক হাতুৰীৰে পিটি পিটি ভাজ দিয়াতকৈ গলাই কোমল কৰি ভাজ দিয়া বহু সহজ কাম।" আজিৰ দিনতো বহুতো ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰী আছে যিসকলে নিজস্ব সু-যুক্তি, সু-উপলব্ধি, স্ব-জ্ঞানেৰে কোনো এটা টিউচনৰ সহায় নোলোৱাকৈ সুখ্যাতিৰে শিক্ষানুষ্ঠান তথা দেশলৈ সুনাম কঢ়িয়াই আনিবলৈ সক্ষম হৈছে। টিউচন ল'ব লাগে বা ল'লেই যে ছাত্ৰ-ছত্ৰীসকল পঢ়াত অতি ভাল হৈ যাব, সেইটো কেতিয়াও ভাবিব নালাগে। মুকলি পৰিৱেশত নিজস্ব উপলব্ধিৰে অধ্যয়ন কৰি কিবা অসুবিধা বা বুজি নাপালেহে টিউচনৰ প্ৰয়োজন বোধ কৰিব লাগে। কেতিয়াও অভিভাৱক কঠোৰ অনুশাসনৰ খাতিৰত টিউচন হ'ব নালাগে বা অভিভাৱকেও বাধ্যবাধকতা

কৰাব নালাগে। অৱশ্যে টিউচন শিক্ষাৰ এটা বেয়া মাধ্যম বুলি ক'বলৈ যোৱা নাই। আমাৰ ছাত্ৰ-ছাত্ৰীসকলে টিউচন লোৱাৰ পৰিৱৰ্তে, পঢ়িবলৈ এটি সুন্দৰ পৰিৱেশ সৃষ্টি কৰি আত্মনিৰ্ভৰশীলতাৰে আত্ম উপলব্ধিৰে আত্ম উপলব্ধিৰে আত্মজ্ঞান বঢ়াই তুলি এগৰাকী মেধাৱী ছাত্ৰ হোৱাৰ উপৰি জীৱন সংগ্ৰামৰ যোগ্য নায়ক হিচাপে গঢ়ি তুলিবলৈ চেষ্টা কৰাটো প্ৰয়োজন।

সকলো বস্তুৰে ভাল-বেয়া দুয়োটা দিশ থকাৰ দৰে টিউচনৰো কিছুমান ভাল আৰু কিছুমান বেয়া দিশ আছে। কিন্তু দুয়ো দিশৰ মাজত সামঞ্জস্য ৰাখিব পৰাটোহে হ'ল এগৰাকী শিক্ষাৰ্থীৰ প্ৰকৃত কৰ্তব্য। টিউচন লোৱাটো নিশ্চয় কোনো বেয়া কথা ক'ব নোৱাৰে। নিজতৈ এগৰাকী শিক্ষিত, গুণী-জ্ঞানী ব্যক্তিৰ পৰা শিক্ষা সম্বন্ধীয় সমাধান বিচৰাটো কোনো লাজৰ কথাও হ'ব নোৱাৰে। আনুষ্ঠানিক শিক্ষাজগতত ব্যক্তিগতভাৱে বাট দেখুৱাই নিয়া প্ৰক্ৰিয়াটোৱে হ'ল টিউচন। এই প্ৰক্ৰিয়াটোত শিক্ষকগৰাকীৰ বাবে শিক্ষাৰ্থীৰ প্ৰয়োজন পূৰোৱাটো যিদৰে কৰ্তব্য শিক্ষাৰ্থীৰ বাবে গুৰু বা শিক্ষকগৰাকীক দক্ষিণা দিয়াটোও এক দায়িত্ব।

আৰম্ভণি ঃ শিক্ষা হৈছে ব্যক্তিৰ শাৰীৰিক আৰু মানসিক বিকাশ সাধনৰ এক প্ৰক্ৰিয়া। অৰ্থাৎ শিক্ষাই মানুহৰ কৰ্মদক্ষতা, শাৰীৰিক সামৰ্থতা, সামাজিক শিষ্টাচাৰ, মানৱীয় গুণ, বিবেচনা শক্তি. পৰিস্কাৰ-পৰিচ্ছন্নতা, কৰ্তব্যবোধ, দায়িত্ববোধ আদি গুণৰ বিকাশ সাধন কৰে। শিক্ষাৰ ওপৰতে জাতি এটাৰ উন্নয়ন, শক্তি, সামৰ্থ, মান-মৰ্যদা আদি নিৰ্ভৰ কৰে। সুস্থ, সবল, শান্তিপূৰ্ণ সামাজিক জীৱন যাপন কৰিবৰ বাবে প্ৰত্যেক ব্যক্তিৰে উপযুক্ত শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰয়োজন। শিক্ষাৰ কোনো বিকল্প নাই। মানৱ জাতি নাৰী আৰু পুৰুষ লৈয়ে গঠিত। সেয়ে পুৰুষ আৰু নাৰী দুয়োৰে সু-শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰয়োজন আছে। কিন্তু বাস্তৱত পুত্ৰ সন্তানক শিক্ষা দিয়াৰ ক্ষেত্ৰত যিমান গুৰুত্ব দিয়া হয়, কন্যা সন্তানৰ ক্ষেত্ৰত সিমান গুৰুত্ব দিয়া দেখা নাযায়। ভাৰতবৰ্ষত নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ পৰম্পৰা প্ৰাচীন বৈদিক সাহিত্যসমূহত নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ তথ্য পোৱা যায়। সেই সময়ত পুৰুষৰ লগতে নাৰীসকলকো শিক্ষা দিয়াৰ ওপৰত গুৰুত্ব দিয়া হৈছিল। আমি বেদত পাওঁ যে বৈদিক যুগত যাগ-যজ্ঞ, পূজা-পাতল, ধৰ্মীয় কাৰ্য আদিত পুৰুষৰ লগতে নাৰীসকলেও অংশগ্ৰহণ কৰিছিল। প্ৰাচীন শাস্ত্ৰত গাৰ্গীমৈত্ৰিয় নামৰ এজনী নাৰীয়ে শ্লোক ৰচনা কৰাৰ উল্লেখ পোৱা যায়। সেইদৰে অগস্ত্য মুনিৰ পত্নী লোপামুদ্ৰা, ঋষি অত্ৰিকন্যা বিশ্ববাৰা, সাবিত্ৰী, ইন্দ্ৰানী আদিয়ে সমাজত বিশেষ ভূমিকা লোৱা কাৰ্যৰ পৰা বুজা যায় যে সিহঁত শিক্ষিত আছিল। খ্ৰীঃপূৰ্ব ষষ্ঠ শতিকাত বৌদ্ধধৰ্মৰ অভ্যুদ্বয়ৰ সময়তো নাৰী স্বাধীনতা আৰু নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ উমান পোৱা যায়। সম্ৰাট অশোকে নিজ কন্যা সংঘমিত্রাক বৌদ্ধ ধর্ম প্রচাৰৰ বাবে সিংহললৈ পঠোৱা ঘটনাটোৰ পৰা নাৰী যে পুৰুষৰ সমকক্ষ আছিল তাকেই প্ৰমাণ কৰে। ভাৰতীয় সমাজত দুৰ্গা, কালী, সৰস্বতী, লক্ষ্মী আদি দেৱীক পূজা কৰা হয়। ইয়াৰ পৰাও প্ৰতীয়মান হয় যে অতীতত ভাৰতবৰ্ষত নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰচলন আছিল আৰু

সমাজত নাৰীসকলৰ মৰ্যাদা উচ্চ আছিল। কিন্তু খ্ৰীষ্ট্ৰীয় দ্বিতীয় শতাব্দীত জন্ম গ্ৰহণ কৰা ঋষি মুনিয়ে ৰচনা কৰা 'মনু সংহিতা'ই সমাজত নাৰী মৰ্যাদাৰ ওপৰত কুঠাৰঘাত কৰে। তেওঁ নাৰীক অকল ভোগ্য পণ্য বুলি মত প্ৰকাশ কৰি নাৰীক সকলো শিক্ষা-দীক্ষা গ্ৰহণ কৰাৰ পৰা বিৰত ৰখাৰ দৰ্শন প্ৰকাশ কৰে। তেতিয়াৰ পৰা পৰম্পৰাগত ভাৰতীয় সমাজত নাৰীসকল অৱহেলিত, পদদলিত আৰু লাঞ্ছিত হোৱাৰ পথ প্ৰশস্ত হয় আৰু নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ ব্যৱস্থাটো গৌণ হৈ পৰে। দ্বিতীয় শকিতাক 'মন সংহিতা' ৰচনা হোৱাৰ পৰা ঊনবিংশ শতিকাৰ আদি ভাগলৈ ভাৰতবৰ্ষত নাৰীসকলৰ বাবে 'অন্ধকাৰ যুগ' বুলি ক'ব পাৰি। কিয়নো এই সময়ছোৱাত নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ বাবে ভাৰতবৰ্ষত বিশেষকৈ হিন্দু সমাজত কোনো উদ্যোগ লোৱা হোৱা নাছিল আৰু নাৰীয়ে চাৰিবেৰৰ মাজত আৱদ্ধ হৈ থাকিবলৈ বাধ্য হৈ পৰিছিল। কিন্তু ভাৰতবৰ্ষত ইংৰাজ ভাইচৰয় লৰ্ড উইলিয়াম বেন্টিংকে ভাৰতত আধুনিক শিক্ষা বিস্তাৰত মনোযোগ দিয়ে আৰু নাৰীসকলকো শিক্ষাৰ অধিকাৰ প্ৰদানৰ দিহা কৰে। তেতিয়াৰ পৰা ভাৰতবৰ্ষত নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ আধনিক পৰম্পৰা আৰম্ভ হয় আৰু পৰৱৰ্তী সময়ছোৱাত ভাৰতবৰ্ষত ইন্দিৰা গান্ধী, কনকলতা, সৰোজিনী নাইডু, পণ্ডিত, মাদাৰ টেৰেছা, ভগ্নী নিবেদিতা আদি বহুতো বিদ্যী নাৰীৰ জন্ম হয়। ১৯৯৮ চনত ইউনিচেফ প্ৰকাশ কৰা এক তথ্য অনুসৰি বিশ্বৰ এক ষষ্ঠাংশ লোক অশিক্ষিত। এই অশিক্ষিত লোকৰ দুই-তৃতীয়াংশ হ'ল নাৰী। আধুনিক ভাৰতৰ সংবিধানে নাৰীক পুৰুষৰ সমান অধিকাৰ প্ৰদান কৰিছে আৰু পুৰুষ নাৰী উভয়ৰে বাবে শিক্ষা বাধ্যতামূলক কৰিছে। কিন্তু দুখৰ বিষয় যে বিজ্ঞানৰ এই চৰম উন্নতিৰ যুগতো শিক্ষাৰ ক্ষেত্ৰত নাৰী পিছ পৰি আছে। নাৰীসকল বাল্য বিবাহ, বলাৎকাৰ, কাৰখানাৰ কৰ্মী, বাটৰ শিল ভঙা, বেশ্যা বৃত্তি গ্ৰহণ কৰা আদিৰ বলি হৈছে। শেহতীয় তথ্য অনুসৰি ভাৰতবৰ্ষত



পুৰুষ আৰু নাৰীৰ শিক্ষাৰ হাৰ ক্ৰমে ৭৫ শতাংশ আৰু ৬৫ শতাংশ। ইয়াৰ পৰা দেখা যায় যে শিক্ষাৰ ক্ষেত্ৰত নাৰীসকল পুৰুষৰ তুলনাত পিছ পৰি আছে। অসম, নাগালেণ্ড, মেঘালয়, অৰুণাচল প্ৰদেশ আদি ৰাজ্যবোৰত নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ হাৰ তেনেই কম। কিন্তু সমাজ তথা দেশ এখনৰ সাৰ্বিক উন্নয়ন, সুখ, শান্তি আৰু শৃংখলাৰ স্বাৰ্থত পুৰুষৰ লগে লগে নাৰীসকলৰো শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰয়োজন আছে।

নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰয়োজনীয়তা : নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ প্ৰয়োজনীয়তাৰ সপক্ষে আমি তলত উল্লেখ কৰা কাৰণকেইটা আগবঢ়াব পাৰো। প্ৰথমত, শিক্ষাই ব্যক্তি এজনৰ শাৰীৰিক আৰু মানসিক বিকাশ সাধন কৰে। নাৰীসকলো যিহেতু মানুহ আৰু পুৰুষৰ সংগী সেয়ে নাৰীসকলৰো বিকাশৰ প্ৰয়োজন আছে। অন্যথা পুৰুষ আৰু নাৰীৰ জীৱনশৈলীত বিসংগতিযে দেখা দি পৰিয়াল তথা সামাজিক জীৱনত বিশৃংখলাৰ সৃষ্টি কৰিব। দ্বিতীয়তে, শিক্ষাই মানুহক যুক্তিবাদী কৰে, বিবেচনা শক্তি বৃদ্ধি কৰে। সেয়ে সামাজিক নীতি-নিয়ম, পৰম্পৰা আদি যুক্তিৰে চালি-জাৰি চাই জীৱনটো অধিক সমৃদ্ধ কৰিবলৈ পুৰুষৰ লগতে নাৰীসকলৰো শিক্ষা গ্ৰহণৰ প্ৰয়োজন আছে। তৃতীয়তে, ভাৰতৰ দুৰ্গম অঞ্চলৰ গাঁওসমূহত আজিও ডাইনী হত্যা, বলাৎকাৰ, গৰ্ভপাত, যৌতুকৰ বাবে স্ত্ৰী হত্যা আদি ঘৃণনীয় কাৰ্য-কলাপ চলি আছে। পুৰুষৰ সমানে নাৰীসকল শিক্ষিত হ'লেহে এনে অপৰাধ ৰোধ কৰিব পৰা যাব। চতুৰ্থতে, মানুহ হৈছে প্ৰকৃতিৰ একমাত্ৰ প্ৰাণী যাৰ মাজত ইতিবাচক গুণৰ লগতে বহুতো নেতিবাচক গুণ আছে, যেনে — স্বাৰ্থপৰতা, হিংসা, অসুয়া, অৰিয়া-অৰি, লোভ, লালসা, ঈৰ্যা ইত্যাদি। এই নেতিবাচক গুণবোৰে সমাজ তথা পৰিয়ালত বিশৃংখলতা আৰু অশান্তিৰ সৃষ্টি কৰে। এইবোৰৰ পৰা হাত সাৰিবলৈ পুৰুষৰ লগতে নাৰীসকলো শিক্ষিত হ'ব লাগিব। পঞ্চমতে, আজিৰ যুগটো হৈছে বিজ্ঞানৰ উন্নতিৰ চৰম যুগ। আমাৰ দৈনন্দিন জীৱনৰ সকলোবোৰ কাৰ্য বিজ্ঞানৰ জৰিয়তে পৰিচালিত হৈ আছে। ইণ্টাৰনেট, কম্পিউটাৰ, মোবাইল ফোন ইত্যাদি আমাৰ দৈনন্দিন জীৱনত হাতৰ মুঠিত কঢ়িয়াই ফুৰা

আহিলা হিচাপে ব্যৱহাৰ হৈ আছে। এইবোৰৰ সঠিক ব্যৱহাৰৰ বাবে পুৰুষৰ লগতে নাৰীসকলো শিক্ষিত হোৱা প্ৰয়োজন। ষষ্ঠতে, পণ্ডিত জৱাহৰলাল নেহৰুৱে কৈছিল, "এজন ল'ৰাক শিক্ষা দিয়া মানে এজন পুৰুষক শিক্ষিত কৰি তোলা, কিন্তু এজনী ছোৱালীক শিক্ষিত কৰা মানে এটা পৰিয়ালক শিক্ষিত কৰি তোলা। আকৌ এজন দার্শনিকে কৈছিল, "সন্তানৰ বাবে এজন পিতৃ এশজন শিক্ষকৰ সমান আৰু এজনী মাতৃ এহেজাৰজন শিক্ষকৰ সমান।" উক্ত বক্তব্যবোৰৰ সত্যতা কোনেও নুই কৰিব নোৱাৰে নিশ্চয়। সেয়ে সন্তানক সু-শিক্ষাৰে শিক্ষিত কৰাৰ স্বাৰ্থত প্ৰতিজন নাৰী শিক্ষিত হোৱা উচিত। সপ্তমতে, সংবিধানে নাৰী-পুৰুষ উভয়কে সমান অধিকাৰ প্ৰদান কৰিছে যদিও অধিকাৰ ভোগ কৰাৰ বাবে সামর্থ, দক্ষতা, সুযোগ, জ্ঞান, বুদ্ধি, বিবেচনা, যুক্তি আদিৰ প্ৰয়োজন। নাৰীয়ে নিজৰ অধিকাৰ সাব্যস্ত কৰাৰ স্বাৰ্থত শিক্ষা গ্ৰহণ অৱশ্যস্তাৱী। অন্তমতে, পুৰুষ প্ৰধান সমাজত নাৰীসকলক সদায় অৱদমিত কৰি ৰখা হয়। ফলত নাৰীয়ে পুৰুষৰ বহতীয়া হৈ নিজৰ স্বাধীনতা বিসৰ্জন দিব লগা হয়। এই স্বাধীনতা উপভোগ কৰাৰ বাবেও নাৰীসকলে শিক্ষা লাভ কৰা জৰুৰী।

সামৰণি ঃ পুৰুষ আৰু নাৰীক লৈয়ে মানৱ সমাজ গঠিত। মানৱ জাতিৰ অস্তিত্ব বৰ্তাই ৰখাত নাৰী-পুৰুষ পৰস্পৰে পৰস্পৰৰ ওপৰত নিৰ্ভৰশীল। মহাপুৰুষ হজৰত মহম্মদে কৈছিল, "পুৰুষ সংগী নোহোৱা নাৰী আৰু নাৰী সংগী নোহোৱা পুৰুষ অসম্পূৰ্ণ মানৱ।" অৰ্থাৎ নাৰীক লৈয়েহে পুৰুষৰ জীৱন সম্পূৰ্ণ হয়। সেয়ে পুৰুষৰ লগতে নাৰীয়েও শিক্ষা গ্ৰহণৰ আৱশ্যকতা আছে। ইয়াৰ বাবে প্ৰতিজন পিতৃ, অভিভাৱক, নেতা, বুদ্ধিজীৱী, শিক্ষিত ব্যক্তিয়ে পুত্ৰ সন্তান আৰু কন্যা সন্তানক সমানে প্ৰাধান্য দি দুয়োকে সমানে শিক্ষিত কৰাৰ মানসিকতা গঠন কৰিব লাগিব আৰু নাৰী শিক্ষাৰ বাবে জনসচেতনতা বৃদ্ধি কৰিব লাগিব আৰু চৰকাৰেও প্ৰয়োজনীয় পদক্ষেপ দৃঢ়তাৰে সৈতে গ্ৰহণ কৰিব লাগিব।

### AIR POLLUTION: THE SILENT KILLER

In 13th November, 2019 issue of Times of India, just one day ahead of Children's day, a brief news appeared with a photo of a teenager with mask on her face, holding a banner, standing all alone in front of a heap of burning garbage, mostly of plastics emitting smoke with the appeal "Allow us to live in good health", "Don't burn polythene"! This one picture speaks volumes about the menace of air pollution and the impending danger to human race and the earth as a whole. But surprisingly most of us in the society are not that much worried as the

class IX standard student from Chabua, about 30 kms east of Dibrugarh studying at Vivekananda Vivekananda Vidyalaya, Laipuli in the outskirt of Tinsukia town. Most of the garbage from household, shops & market

area are dumped there and regularly burnt there as a way of disposal in 21st century! It is virtually impossible, as per the news report, or tormenting to pass by the area but people are passing by as they have no other option. Not only small township like Chabua, Tinsukia, Dibrugarh or Sivasagar (Remember the mound of plastics and polythine just

at the eastern end of the town by the roadside ?), the gate way to north east as well as the nerve centre of the entire region Guwahati, is now facing the danger of increasing air pollution almost in the similar line of country's capital city Delhi! Fortunately the silver lining is that as Greta Thunberg, the lone crusader from Sweden could be able to draw the attention of world leaders after her single handed effort since her childhood, so also Miss Asthanandini Borgohain, the student from Chabua succeeded in drawing attention of the

Executive Officer of local Municipal Board, and he levied penalty to such offenders of dumping and burning garbage.

We all are aware that atmospheric air comprises of three types of primary or stable gases as



Nitrogen (N), Oxygen(O), and Argon(A) of which Nitrogen is main building blocks of life being the major component of protein, Oxygen is necessary for plant and animal life and Argon is an odourless, colorless and inert gas. Others are trace or variable gases – namely Methane, Hydrogen, Helium, Neon, Carbon Di oxide, Ozone and Krypton etc.

Therefore, for life to exist in good health on earth, we need clean and non contaminated or non polluted air. It was there before the era of rapid urbanisation, industrialisation and introduction of various motorised vehicles as mode of transportation and machineries for production of goods to ease our day to day life. But it is not so now and problem of pollution is now a global one.

#### What is air pollution?

It is the release of pollutants or contaminants into atmospheric air as a result various human activities, that are bad or detrimental to human health & planet earth as a whole.

As air is not visible unless it blows, so also air pollution, unless it becomes smoky or cloudy as it happened in Delhi. Its impact on human health is likewise not visible at the beginning but progresses slow and insidiously and by the time it is obvious with signs and symptoms, it is usually very late, and the victim gradually advances towards death. That is why it is called a silent killer!

There are outdoor and indoor air pollution. Outdoor pollution is the result of urbanization, more specifically rapid urbanization, industrialization, energy production and its use, transport, agricultural practice using machineries for more production (as tractor for ploughing, harvesting and threshing, water pumps for irrigation), dirt and dust, waste management etc. whereas indoor pollution is caused by burning of firewood and use of kerosene for cooking, lighting and other domestic purposes, cowdung cake for cooking.

#### Some awful facts:

As per study by WHO, outdoor pollution kills 4.2 million people per year in our country as against indoor pollution taking lives of 3.8 million persons which amounts to 8 million people losing their lives due to air pollution most of which could have been averted by preventing air pollution!

Another study awfully reveals that 91% of world population are living in such condition where density of suspended particulate matter (PM) in air is much

higher than level set by WHO! In our country, this density is increased by about 69%, thereby reducing life span of individual by a horrific 8.3 years in last two decades. In the capital city of Delhi, suspended PM density in the atmospheric air was 113 micrograms per cubic meter and as a result, life span of Delhi residents has been reduced by 10 years as per study done in 2016. With further deterioration of situation there is every possibility of further reduction in average life span! As per same study of 2016, nine lakhs people died due to effects of air pollution in the country! Apart from the capital city, other towns where high PM 2.5 level recorded are Faridabad, Varanasi, Gaya, Patna, Lucknow & Agra.

#### Effects of air pollution:

Since air pollution directly effects health of people who are inhaling, it becomes a matter of grave concern for any conscientious citizen of the country! Health hazards due to air pollution recorded so far are:

Low birth babies, most of whom failed to thrive, Pulmonary Tuberculosis, Heart disease, various respiratory diseases, Asthma, Cancer of lungs, ear, nose and throat and even eye disease like cataract!

Out of all deaths due to heart disease, 25% are attributed to effects of air pollution and about 1.8 million death are attributed to various Respiratory problems, Asthma and cancer of lungs.

Some of the particulate matters are so fine and tiny that they pass into blood easily in the lungs, reach brain and start damaging the brain cells! More lead and mercury in the inhaled air due to pollution, cause irreparable damage to children's brain and kidney and Central nervous system respectively. Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH) emitted from traffic

smoke, wild fire smoke (as now in Delhi) leads to irritation and watering of eyes and damages lungs, blood and cause even cancer of liver!

#### Any way out?

After being aware of the horrifying situation as a result of human activities, should we allow it to



continue to reach a point of no return? Definitely not. It is all in our hands and situation is still not out of our control. Therefore, let us put our hands together and act. Line of action will have to be many prongs – at government, society and at our personal level and effort should be a sustaining one.

Since motorised vehicle run by fossil fuels like petrol and diesel, are a major source of outdoor pollution, the number of them on the roads needs to be controlled, restricted and minimised as far as practicable. Public transport needs to be improved and made commuter friendly so that people use them more and more, thereby minimising use of personal vehicles as mode of travelling. Vehicle run by solar energy, electric cars and train to be encouraged to replace gradually those run by fossil fuel. For short distance travel, cycling, the oldest mode of transport should be encouraged and policy should be made for keeping separate lanes for cyclists while planning road construction.

Deforestation is another reason for pollution as Carbon Di Oxide exhaled into the air can not be absorbed by less number of plantation thereby its quantity is increased in the atmosphere which is detrimental to life. Reforestation and afforestation leading to green coverage will help in combating air pollution to a great extent.

Advancement of modern life is gauged by the amount of garbage or waste produced by the society. This figure is on the increase day by day because of rampant use of disposables ranging from household necessities to commercial establishments and health care establishments. Improper or unscientific disposal of tons and tons of such waste is another major contributor to pollution. So, proper and scientific disposal of such waste, be it from household, commercial houses, industry or hospitals is a must and all responsible for disposal should do

their job in right earnest and religiously! Segregation of daily waste into biodegradable and non biodegradables to be started right at the source to facilitate their proper handling and final disposal. This measure will reduce dust and dirt too which also contribute to ever increasing pollution. Once thought to be modern day boon, the plastic and polythines now turned into a menace (a sort of Frankenstein!) for the society from view point of pollution. They never degrade but remains intact for years in the soil spoiling its fertility, so also those dumped in water bodies, rivers and ocean causes harm to flora and fauna and marine lives. Similarly, burning of plastics and polythine release poisonous gas into the atmosphere increasing pollution. Such foolish act by people must stop.

Cleanliness of surroundings, be it residential premises or business or public establishments will contribute to a great extent in combating or preventing air pollution.

Educating people about the need for good and pollution free environment for a healthy life and how to preserve for good of mankind is very important. Many people in our society, even educated ones have either no idea or very vague idea about environment and pollution. So to succeed in our attempt to make environment pollution free, educating such people with awareness program with the help of audio visual presentation is very important. Many educated people are not aware that plastics and polythines should never be burnt and they keep on burning them to dispose without any hesitation!

To conclude, starting from Government authority, law makers and implementing authority to society and individual citizen—all must work together to combat menace of air pollution and we should all remember that it is a team work, not an individual task.

### Moocs: Its Application in Present Education System - An Overview

Education with technology is considered as most promising development in education. With technology globalization, the concept of learning and teaching has undergone enormous changes. In this regards, Ministry of Human Resources Development has taken many initiatives to provide an digitally advanced education in India.

MOOCs is one of the major concerned areas where the government has taken a step ahead to educate students with even vast subjects.

#### **MOOCs Defined:**

Massive Open Online Courses, or MOOCs, are online courses that allow participants free access and unrestricted participation to any course of their choice. Besides the conventional modes of teaching such as lectures, videos and reading material; MOOCs also provide a platform for interactive forums.

MOOCs are further divided into two categories – cMOOCs and xMOOCs.

- cMOOCs are MOOCs that allow for dynamic development of study material. That is, instead of having a pre-planned set of reading materials and courseware, the material will be developed through online discussions and collaborations among learners taking the course across the globe.
- xMOOCs, on the other hand, believe in the conventional approach where the courses are well-structured with pre-selected reading and reference materials.

A massive open online course (MOOC) is a free Web-based <u>distance learning</u> program that is designed for the participation of large numbers of geographically dispersed students. **MOOCs** are a recent and widely researched development in distance **education**, first introduced in 2006 and emerged as a popular mode of learning in 2012.

The <u>acronym</u> MOC is pronounced with a long *oo* sound, to rhyme with *kook* rather than *book*. The Oxford online dictionary added the term (as "Mooc") in August 2013.

The government has linked MOOCs with a new portal named 'Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds', in short, SWAYAM, which is said to present students with an opportunity to study anything from a list of 2000 courses out of which 200 are currently available for registration.

According to the Ministry of Human Resource and Development, it is a great approach in heading



towards the development by going completely digital. In the coming years, MOOCs would be starting in India on a large scale.

Going completely digital, students would be able to receive the best, detailed and updated knowledge of various subjects online.

The UGC along with the HRD Ministry has launched MOOC programme in India for higher secondary, bachelors and masters degrees. This will cover a wide range of subjects that may or may not be taught in the regular campus.

#### What is MOOC in Education?

A massive open online course (MOOC /muĐk) is an online course aimed at unlimited participation and open access via the web. ... MOOCs are a recent and widely researched development in distance education, first introduced in 2006 and emerged as a popular mode of learning in 2012.

A MOOC may be patterned on a college or university course or may be less structured. Although MOOCs don't always offer academic credits, they provide education that may enable certification, employment or further studies.

#### When did MOOCs Start?

Thrun founded a company called Udacity in February 2012 which began to develop and offer MOOCs for free. In April 2012, Andrew Ng and Daphne Koller, two other Stanford CS professors, started a company called Coursera which partnered with universities in preparing and offering MOOCs.

#### A Brief History

MOOCs were first started in 2008, created by George Siemens and Stephen Downs, and was called "Connectivism and Connective Knowledge/2008" or CCK08. It was created as a credit course for the University of Manitoba. CCK08 had 25 students who had paid fees for the course and around 2200 learners who took the course for free.

In 2011, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) Open Course Ware (OCW) became the first large collections of MOOC resources made available by a university. In 2012,

MIT and Harvard spearheaded the edX initiative for the promotion of MOOCs.

MOOCs really took off in 2012, when Professors Sebastian Thrun and Peter Norvig of Stanford University offered the online course called "Introduction to Artificial Intelligence". This course had approximately 1,600,000 students participating from 190 countries. After the success of Intro to Artificial Intelligence, Thrun and Nrovig started Udacity, a business model for online knowledge sharing. There are also a few other MOOCs providers, include Coursera and EdX.

SWAYAM is an ambitious upcoming MOOC platform by the Indian government. Under SWAYAM, professors of centrally-funded institutions in India—such as Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs), and central universities—will offer online courses to citizens of India

The system allows the transfer of credits that a college student earns from a course directly into their academic records. SWAYAM is a programme initiated by Government of India and designed to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity and quality. The objective of this effort is to take the best teaching learning resources to all, including the most disadvantaged.

#### How does it work?

A Massive open online Course (MOOC) is a free online course that supports learning in a variety of different subjects and is open to anyone with access to a computer and the internet. MOOCs aim to connect learners from across the globe with educators and with each other.

#### Quadrant Approach:

Quadrant-I is e-Tutorial: which shall contain: Video and Audio Content in an organised form, Animation, Simulations, video demonstrations, Virtual Labs, etc.

Quadrant-II is e-Content: which shall contain: PDF, Text, e-Books, illustrations, video demonstrations, documents and Interactive simulations wherever required.

Quadrant-III is Web Resources: which shall contain: Related Links, Wikipedia Development of Course, Open source Content on Internet, Case Studies, books including e-books, research papers & journals, Anecdotal information, Historical development of the subject, Articles, etc.

Quadrant-IV is Self-Assessment: which shall contain: Problems and Solutions, which could be in the form of Multiple Choice Questions, Fill in the blanks, Matching Questions, Short Answer Questions, Long Answer Questions, Quizzes, Assignments and solutions, Discussion forum topics and setting up the FAQs, Clarifications on general misconceptions.

#### The Advantages of MOOCs:

- 1. Courses are offered for free
- 2. Access to courses offered by professors at the top schools
- 3. Courses are available to a vast and diverse audience across the globe
- 4. Learners' performance can be monitored easily using the data captured during the start of courses
- 5. Both professors and learners get world-wide exposure, thus improving pedagogical techniques and knowledge sharing
- 6. Can be used as a tool in a blended learning program, where students can access more information than what is provided in the class

## The Disadvantages of MOOCs:

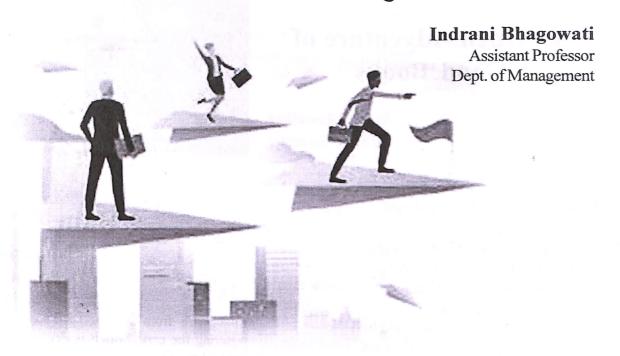
- 1. Can't provide for personalized courseware and attention from a tutor

#### e) When to do it?

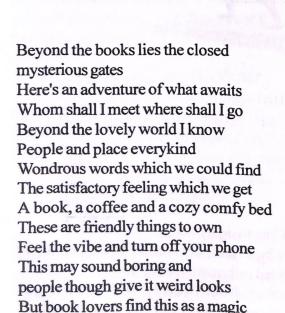

To change yoursely, You should try to use positive lines about onesely and reading it out several lines a day, say for one or two weeks.

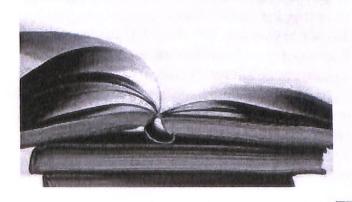

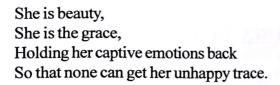

## CHILD LABOUR

UNICEF define child labour as work that exceeds a minimum number of hours, depending on the age of a child and on the type of work, such work is considered harmful to the child and should therefore be eliminated. According to the UNICEF, there are over 250 million children being exploited for forced work. In terms of international treaties, there are 218 million children working illegally today. Out of these children 126 million are engaged in hazardous work, such as mining, handing chemicals etc. In developing countries, many children do not have choice and control over their work and education as they are from poor backgrounds. But in eastern and developed countries children an choose their work to earn extra pocket money. In South Asian countries children works do not have opportunities for leisure and play. Worldwide, children are engaged in agriculture labour, mining, manufacturing domestic helper, construction worker, scavenging and begging on the streets also. It is universally recognised fact that children are most valuable assets of a nation and their significance in nation building process cannot be undermined. Children of today are the potential citizen of tomorrow. The quality of life they enjoy today would ultimately determine the quality of future population of a nation.



<u>CAUSES</u>: Poverty is the ultimate or a dominant factor of child labour. Families those who are below poverty line, forced their children to work to help their household income.

## **TOURISM IN ASSAM: PROSPECTS** OF DIMA HASAO

Dima Hasao earlier called North Cachar Hills district is an administrative district in the state of Assam in Northeastern India. The district headquarter Haflong is the only hill station in Assam, a tourist paradise, also named the Switzerland of the north-east.

The present Dima Hasao district, or formerly North Cachar Hills district was included in

the old Cachar district with Asalu being only police outpost. In 1880, this portion was constituted into a sub-division with headquarters Gunjung under Cachar district. This headquarters was shifted to Halflong in 1895. Since then, Halflong has continued to be the head-

quarters. In 1951, after the adoption of the Indian constitution, North Cachar Hills ceased to be a part of Cachar district. This part along with mikir Hills constituted a new civil district named "United District of North Cachar and Mikir Hills", which went into effect on 17 November 1951.

Presently, the district headquarter of Dima Hasao is located at Halflong. The district occupies an area of 4,888 square kilometers. It is the third largest district of Assam after Karbi Anglong and Sonitpur district. Dima Hasao District is surrounded by karbi Anglong (E) and Nagaland in the Northeast, Manipur on the East, Hojai District on the North, karbi Anglong Dist. (W) on the North-West,

Meghalaya on the West and Cachar district on the South. It comprises three subdivisions: (I) Halflong (II) Maibang and (III) Diyungbra.

In 2006, the Indian government named Dima Hasao one of the country's 250 most backward

districts (out of a total of Regions Grant



Fund Programme (BRGF).

The population of the district has increased considerably from 40,812 in 1901 to 54, 319 in 1961 and further to 188,079 and 214,102 in 2011, (Source: wwwnchills.gov.in) The district has a population density of 44 inhabitants per square ki-



lometer.

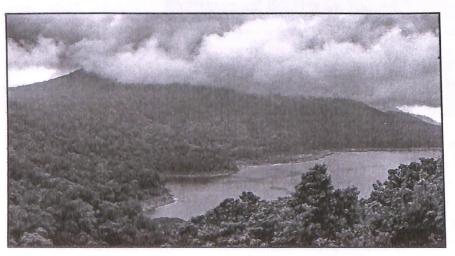
The major indigenous communities inhabiting the district are Dimasa Kachari, Karbi, Zeme Naga, Hmar, Kuki, Biate and number of minor indigenous communities whhich includes Bodo Kachari, Hrangkhol, Khasi-Pnars, Ronggmei Naga, Khelma and Vaiphei. Non-indigenous communities includes Bengali, Nepali tribes, Deshwali tribes and few other communities who have made the district their home.

The major tribal languages spoken in the district are Dimasa, Zeme, Hmar, Kuki, Biate, Hrangkhol, Khasi and Khelma. The major non tribal languages spoken in the district are Assamese, bengali, Nepali and Halflong Hindi (a speech from of Hindi). Halflong Hindi is the lingua franca in the Dima Hasao.

An Insight into Dima Hasao Tourism, Assam The literal translation of the name Dima Hasao comes from Dimasa language and means Dimasa Hills. Tourist attractions in Dima Hasao include hills, rivers, waterfalls and cultural hotspots. Tourism is at an all-time high and there have been upgrades in the hospitality measures in the district on a great scale. One of the must visit places near Dima Hasao is Haflong which is adorned with a natural lake, temples, few historic bungalows built during the British era and gorgeous churches. It is a beautiful hill station in the state of Assam and is also the headquarter of Dima Hasao district. The d place has many tourist attractions. It is the only hill station

in the state of Assam and is visited by many travelers throughout the year. A tour of this hill station is absolutely breathtaking. Haflong hill station is often called as the White Ant Hillock and has a very rich cultural heritage. Among the many sightseeing places the greatest attraction of the place is the Haflong Hill whose picturesque beauty appeals to the people. The nature lovers are sure to be allured by this place. The Haflong Lake is another beautiful spot of this destination where one will be mesmerized. This lake is perfect tourist spot for several reasons and located at the heart of the hill station. One of the largest natural water bodies of Assam, Haflong Lake offers a variety of leisure activities, like boating. The lake is well-maintained and clean as it is protected by Dima Hasao Tourist-Forest Department and Dima Hasao Autonomous Council. The surroundings of the lake offer a haven for thousands of migratory birds in winter. Haflong Lake can be visited all through the year as the temperature is soothing with an average rate of 21 degree Celsius. Another interesting thing to do in and around Dima Hasao is to visit Jatinga and witness the mysterious event of birds committing suicide. On meeting several conditions, all the migratory birds start committing suicide making it a sad event which has no scientific explanation yet. It has been observed by the villagers that during the months of August and November, the birds of varied species die out of mysterious reasons. This occurred espe-

cially during the dark, foggy nights with no moon in the sky. The scientists deciphered this mind-boggling phenomenon when they understood that the birds, which were either native or local migrants, got hit by bamboos as they got attracted to the light of the village. Without any natural lighting which was enhanced by foggy conditions, the birds got dazed and hit the bamboo poles, which were erected by the villagers





who feared that these birds who swooped in during the dark of the night were actually spirits of the dead that wished to harm them. So as to protect themselves, they tried to catch the birds with the bamboo poles which lead to the birds dying after getting hit by them. After deciphering the phenomenon the scientists and environmental activists have taken up the job of educating the villagers of what caused the birds to commit suicide and why it should not be practised. Mainly, due to this curious phenomenon, travellers come in between the months of August to November, especially ornithologists and bird watchers. The view of the sunrise from this place is an amazing sight to be witnessed. Located in the hilly region of the Mahur River, the little town of Maibong also enjoys a lot of tourist attention as it is located only 50 kms from Haflong. Serenaded with mountains, waterfalls and many historical relics, Maibong is a must visit in Assam. The town used to be the capital city of the old Kachari Rulers between the years of the 1500s to 1700s. The relics which were sculptured and carved during those time period have been preserved in a museum of Haflong District. People mainly visit Maibong to catch a glimpse of the famous tworoofed monolithic temple Ramchandi which has insurrections that date back to the 1750s. This beautiful little town has many exquisite waterfalls to visit. The other notable sightseeing places are Umrangso, Harangajao, Thuruk, Panimoor, Hajong and Laisong. Ethnic On 31 August this year, the Haflong Etnic Street food market was inaugurated. The market is a concept developed and started by Haflong Municipal Board and Dima Hasao Tourism in collaboration with Blue Hills Society and Haplou. The method is unique as people will get to experience and savor the unique cuisines of different tribal delicacies of Haflong. There will be also local talents displaying their skills on the street corner. Visitors can savor the delicious street food and at the

same time they can also enjoy the view of Haflong Lake. The street food and displaying talents mela will be functioned every Saturday evening. The platform will be like street food market of Bangkok, Delhi etc. It will not only boost tourism but it will also generate job opportunity for unemployed youths. Karbi's Ok Aphek Angthin and Vo Ok with Nempo, Hmar dish Sizo Maipak, Changban a traditional sticky rice cake steamed in banana leaves, Dimasa's Judima a kind of rice wine, Honohaih Yaoyaba popularly known as stir fried pork, Jaintia's Tuntoh which pork cooked with fermented soyabean, Ja-doh, a rice boiled with pig head's meat or organs, Naga pork cooked with pickled bamboo shoots area few tribal delicacies of the district. The picturesque Dima Hasao has three of Assam's highest peaks, abundant flora and fauna, diverse ethnic groups, waterfalls as well as megalithic remains of the past. Haflong is the only hill station in Assam but the place has not been developed to its potential. If entrepreneurs invest in the tourism sector in Dima Hasao, it can act as the engine of growth in the otherwise underdeveloped district. In order to boost up the tourism industry in the district certain suggestions are put forth. Calendar events could be regularly organised so that tourists can plan their itinerary well in advance. The local people could be trained in areas like hospitality, home-stays, adventure tourism and as tour guides. There are a few homestay options in the district but the number has to be increased. Connectivity is no problem as the roads are good and train services from Badarpur are also slated to start. Biking tours to the district can also be an option to boost up the industry. One of the utmost necessities is the sensitization of the police to make the place tourist-friendly. Foreign tourist arrivals in India are expected to increase from nine per cent to 12 per cent this year and Assam hopes to get a share of that.

THE AGE OF CRYPTO CURRENCY: How bitcoin and digital money are challenging the global Economic order.

A cryptocurrency is a digital asset designed to work as a medium of exchange that uses strong cryptocurrency to secure financial transactions, control the creation of additional units and verify the transfer of assets. Cryptocurrency uses decentralized control as opposed to centralized digital currency and central banking system. The decentralized control of each cryptocurrency works through distributed ledger technology, typically a blockchain that serves as a public financial transaction database.

The first decentralized cryptocurrency, bitcoin was created in 2009 by Pseudonym ous develops satoshi N akam oto. It used SHA-256, a cryptographic hash function, as its proof-of-w ork schem e.InA pril2011, N am ecoin w as created as an attemptatform ing a decentralized DNS, which would make intermetcensorship very difficult soon after, in O ctober 2011, Z itecoin was realiased. Itw as the first successful cryptocurrency to use csryptas its hash function of SHA-256.

<u>Cryptocurrency in India</u>: In India, cryptocurrency has been available since 2012. And at present in India, there are 11 trading platforms and around 1 million users of bitcoin. At the moment RBI

has banned the transactions of bitcoin in India. So one cannot use to cryptocurrency for the payment of goods and services. In 2018, during the union budget declaration the Indian Government declared that cryptocurrencies such as bitcoins werent a legal tender. There is no protection available to those using and trading them or dealing in them.

According to the Indian Government people using these types of currencies should take certain caution because there is no legal protection for these currencies. And no help can be gained by the people from the outside if some fraud is faced by the people. Regarding the future of cryptocurrency in India an expert committee also constituted to measure the risk involve in it. This committee will examine the action of cryptocurrencies and release the report in few months. Some countries are accepting the cryptocurrencies while some are not, some of them are yet to make their decision. One major hurdle in the path of Indian investors, who are interested in investing in cryptocurrency, is the confusion about its legal status, While they are not recognised by the RBI or any other authority in India, as a currency. It is much more difficult to track illegal activities in cryptocurrency space. It has been reported that a lot of transactions related to human trafficing, drugs, cartels, cartels, terror, funding is being done in cryptocurrencies.

India needs to have proper regulations vis-avis cryptocurrencies which are suited to its needs, and supporting the block chain technology application.

The court also ruled out that the Indian Constitution mandates the recognition of a third gender on official documents and that Article 15 bans discrimination based on gender identity.

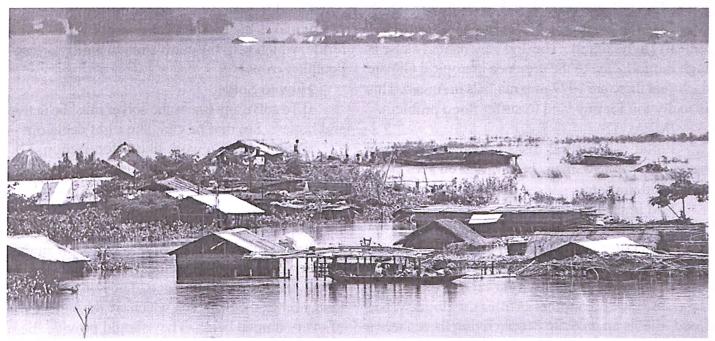

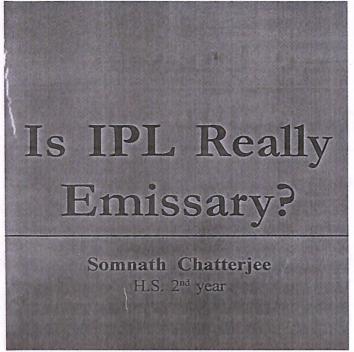


years and is believed to bring prosperiting to the family And the most astonishing fact is that no injuries have been reported so far!

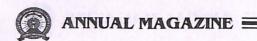

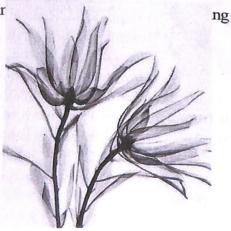

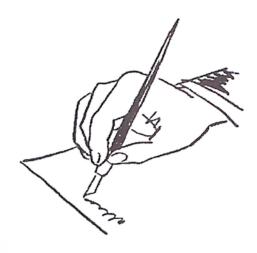

# Essay Writing on Demonetization in India

Demonetization can defined as retirement of old unit of currency and replacement with a new currency unit. The main reason for demonetization is to combat inflation, corruption from a country. In 2016, the Indian Government decided to demonetize the 500 and 1000 rupee notes. These notes accounted for 86% of the country's cash supply as per the report given in the newspaper, "The Assam Tribune". The government's goal was to eliminate black money and promote a cashless economy. In 2015, Zimbabwean government also demonetized the Zimbabwean dollar in order to combat the country's inflation. When Prime Minister Modiji announced that Rs. 500/- and 1000/- note would cease to be the legal tender from 9th of November, the whole country was stunned. This decision caused sensation in the whole country. Social media was flooded with messages and information. So many people tried to invest in gold. I have a showroom of gold Jewellery in the city of Guwahati. I saw huge number of people gathering in my shop at line of demonetization. So, PM Modi announced that people could get only Rs. 4000/- of old denomination exchanged with the new one. Big queves before the banks and ATM's become the order of the day. The last date for the whole process was 30th of December. The person could deposit the old cash worth Rs. 2.5 lac till the said date. The main objective of this move was to curb the black money.

Corruption from the country. The new currency which replaced the old one is of denomination of Rs. 500/- and 2000/-. Though the people faced a lot of inconvenience owing to shortage of funds, they did not criticize the government for the move Prime minister also addressed the people telling that it was a mahayajna () and they must offer their ahuti () in it.

The most interesting thing regarding the demonetization that I noticed is that people are devising various unique methods for transforming their black money in to white one. Some of these methods are as following:

- 1. Depositing money in the accounts of their poor relatives, staffs, friends, chartered accountants, family members etc.
- 2. Hiring labours for some rupees ranging from Rs. 500/- to 700/- for becoming the part of long queues in front of banks.
  - 3. Paying salaries in advance.
  - 4. Paying dues.
  - 5. Paying loans forcibly.
- 6. Paying a few months remuneration to their employes. Decision will lead to the development of the economy. Moreover Government believed that the move could push the people to switch to online payment, which is more trasparent and accountable, a crucial step towards digital India citizens of India were given 50 days to legally exchange or



deposit their hard earned white money with banks. The reaction of the people was mixed. When the bold move was appreciated by many, few others who had billions of black cash, ran like cockroa ches searching for sources to convent their black money to white. The cap of Rs. 2500 withdraw per card per day and maximum withdrawal of Rs. 24000 per account per week made the people of India furious. Citizens turned against the Government for improper planning and for not printing adequate amount of new currency. A few people fainted and few people died, thus enented a negative impact on the move. Opposition parties attacked the Government and asked them to roll back the decision, but a case filed again the demonetisation was nejicted by the apex court. When large and medium class shops and vendors moves to pos machines, small scale rendor started using pay in and swipe for transactions. Income tax authorities caught people who had thousands of crore of black money. Big marriages which spent crores of rupees were stalled. Though there was no limit for online transactions many vendor did not accept online cash or cheque which compelled the families to cut down marriage expenses. The 2.5 lake withdraw limit for marriages was unaccepted for many Indian families. There is a saying in the Bhagavat Gita, the honest are always protected and the friends are always prosecuted. The black money holders played really well with banking officials playing them up to 30% commission of the amount deposited. Central Government has interacted IT department to conduct viaducts and sue the people who have cheated the country. So pu the prevailing practices, bank account holder compulsorily needs to provide the bank, the aadhar card number. In addition, if any individual is depositing over Rs. 25,00,000 needs to disclose the sources of generation of fend. As the Aadhar card number is unique and it enable the bank and IT deportment to link all the accounts having the same registered AADHAR number, if any party is trying to escape the situation by depos-

iting the entire fund in more than one account, it will be easier for the IT department to track such measures. As the government revenue increases, it will strengthen the national economy. It is expected as the government revenue increases, the government will enhance economic development and Social welfare. No doubt, this

Besides these points given above, the bank employers also became corrupted. They started giving new currencies to their big clients in denomination of more than 4000/- in a day. Hence, equality will prevail in the country. There will be no regional disparities in the country which in turn leads to economic development of the country. There shall be no huge expenditures on marriages and other ceremonies. The goods will become cheap Indian Currency shall get respect at the international market. Corruption shall be down to a great extent as people will stop the tendency of accumulating money using wrong means. It will bridge the gap between the poor and the rich. But this inconvenience shall be temporary and for short term. As per RBI, 87% transactions in India an cash transactions and this loophole is used by competed people to build a parallel economy with unaccounted money This parallel economy hampers the growth and development of the country. No doubt, this step will affect general people to some extent but for the benefit of future generations. Such decisions are inevitable. We should welcome such brave step of Indian government which will curb black money to some extent. It was not the first time that India has demonetized its currency. In was done in 1946 and 1978 by Morarji Desai in order to crab coemption. There is a saying that today



pain in tomorrows Joy. All these problem could not be solved over night. But, Modijee ever accounced that the demonetized notes are accepted in some emergency places like hospital, petrel pumps, rail-way department etc. But the corrupted people rushed in these places and exchanged their old notes and buy huge medicines, railway tickets etc. People started giving old currency notes to the render, shop-keeper and the poor vegetable seller. Demonetization can also be used to promote cash less Economy. As PM Modi said, we might not be a completely cashless society soon but at least we can be "less cash economy." Under cashless economy, people prefer to pay for goods and services in digital for-

mat than the cash.

birth etc.

There are three exceptions to this general rule of non discrimination:

a) The state is permitted to make any special provision to women & children.

b) The state is free to make special ar-

rangements for socially and economically background peoples or schedule Caste & Schedule Tribes.

c) State can make special provision for the betterment of the socially & economically backward section of the society.

So, this was explanation of the article 15 of the Indian constitution. We hope that article 15 will entitle a dignified life to the citizens of all economically and socially backward classes and STC, SCs.



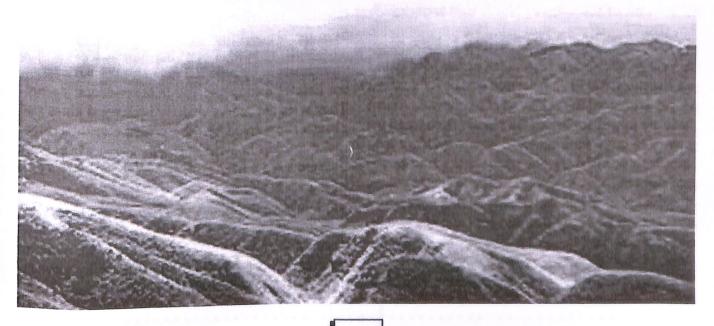
# North East India - An Unexplored Slice of paradise

Introduction: Tea is a piquant beverage commonly prepared by pouring hot or boiling water over cured leave of the "Camellia Sinensis". India is the second largest tea producer in the world after China. In India apart from Assam tea is cultivated in Darjeeling. Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Sikkim and almost in all of the state of North East India etc.

Tea Clanters: Assam is the tea - hub of India. In Assam, the Asia's largest tea estate Monabaria tea Estate, with 1373 hectares under Williamson Magor is situated in the district of Sunitpur. In Assam there are large number of tea planter from small tea grower to large multinational company. If we look back into our history tea was planted first by the Britishers in India. It is very familiar to see the culture of Britisher in tea estates of only Assam but also tea planters are basically devided into two classes Executive class or Management and staff and dabour class.

<u>Life and Culture</u>: The lifestyle and culture of

both the categories of people that is executive class and worker class is very different from each other. It is quite common that executive's stay in a very lavish lifestyle whereas the labour's stay in a pathetic life but from last year there is quite improvement in their lives after the introduction of various schemes. Tea-tribes or worker are original belong from Jharkhand, Uttarkhand and Chhatisgarh who were brought by colonial planters to work in the tea Estates during the pre-independence period. They were the predominately backward class and always suppressed by the upward class. Clanters make barracks known as "Coolie Line" which were overcrowded where each labour get twenty - feet of area for their personal use. Even in the anoint days labourers were not allowed to make the workers of the nearby garden nor allowed to take leave if they were unwell. With the increase of awareness and necessary steps taken by government their life terrible life is changing. Apart from all



these tea labourers used to have lets of children so that each garden could garner enough labour few. In addition to this many tea garden manager heaped severe atrocities on them more mere pleasure by the English Canter and even by the Indian till before the last 10-15 years ago. Because of the atrocities tea labourer became mentally unstable and that's why Britisher set up mental hospital in Tezpur to keep the lunatic workers. Even they did not get proper medical treatment nor proper wage. But with the coming of certain certification like "Trust Tea, Trade Fair there condition is changing" Still there are number of labour who were unaware of this things and still they are facing exploitation. The enactment of Clantation labour Act 1951 compelled employers to make proper education facilities. But it is very disappointing to see that illiterate tea estate workers does not understand the importance of sending their children to school. About 50% of labour workers children do not attend School and engaged in the work of tea plucking and girl child became "aye" (governess) to the children of Manager. About 20% children access pre-primary education in Anganwadi Kendras Music and dance is really a important component of the community. 'Thum air' is a famous folk dance from among these community. Among these tribes, there are many youth who are becoming better education and becoming professionals. Same of the association who are working as an instrument to improve their condition are:-

(1) Assam chah Mazdoor Sangha



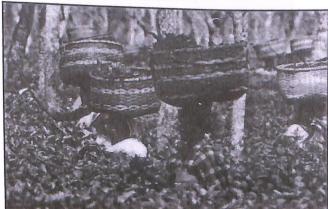

Because of the intiative taken by the these association many welfare schemes has been set up. Hospital creches were built up.

In the other ways life of tea executive are quite different from tea worker. There life is also about to manage and control every matter. Tea Garden executives includes - General Manager, Manager, Deputy manager, Assistant Manager, Medical Officers and welfare officer. There life is full of adventure, fun admist the sprawling bungalows, retinue of servant and evening in club. The English culture is still prevalent in tea garden and there fear only candidate who has fluency in speaking English are able to apply for the post. He must know how were a tea etc. Apart from this his wife must be expert in managing the servant. Tea Garden must have a good table manner too. Most of the tea garden in Assam are situated in a secluded place and therefore are available fer them for recreational facilities. Even tea Estates Managers are addressed as "Saheb" and his wife are as "Mem Saheb". The manager has to supervise the plantation work from that to plucking to processing to palking and transport to auction house.

<u>Conclusion</u>: It is true that there is a gap in different level of work in every field. But no one should try to exploit other. Hence we can concluded with the hope that tea garden worker life will improved in the future.

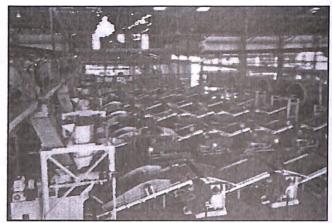

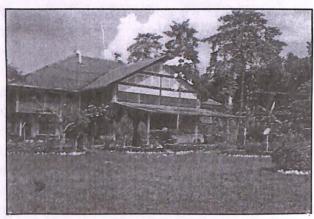




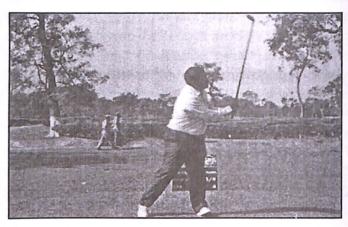

### Formation of the Moon

Earth is only natural satellite, the Moon is largest relative to its planet then any other satellite in the solar system.

During the 'Apollo program', rocks from the Moon's surface were brought to Earth. Radiometric dating of these rocks has shown the moon to be  $4.53 \pm .1$  billion years old, at least 30 million years after the solar system was formed. Now evidence suggests the Moon formed even later,  $4.48 \pm 0.02$  Ga, or 70 - 110 million years after the start of the Solar System.

Theories for the formation of the Moon must explain its late formation as well as the following facts. First the Moon has a low density (3.3 times that of water, compared to 5.5 for the earth) and a small metallic core. Second, there is virtually no water or other volatiles on the moon. Third, the Earth and Moon have the same oxygen 'Isotopic Signature' (relative abundance of the oxygen iso-

topes) of the theories that have been proposed to account for there phenomens, only one is widely accepted. The giant impact hypothe sis purposes that the noon originated after a body the size of Mars strerk the proto Earth a glancing blow.

The collission between impactor, sometimes named 'Theia', and the Earth releases about 100 million times more energy then the impact that caused the extinction of the dinosaurs. This was enough to vaporise some of the Earth's outer layers and melt both bodied.

A portion of the mantle materials was ejected into orbit around the Earth the giant impact hypo thesis predicts that the Moon was depleted on metallic materials, explaining its abnormel composition. The eject a in orbit around the Earth could have condersed into a single body within a couple of weeks. Under the influence of its own gravity the ejected materials became a more sphonecel body. The Moon.

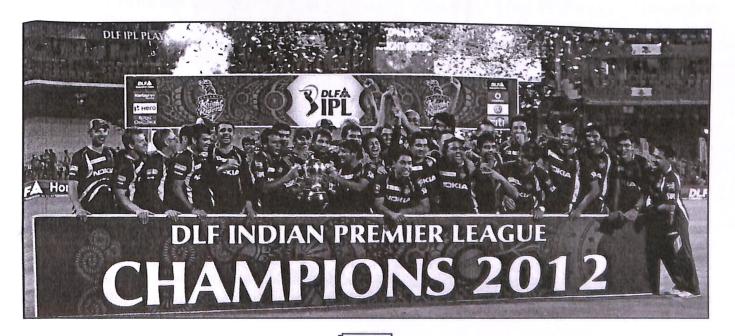

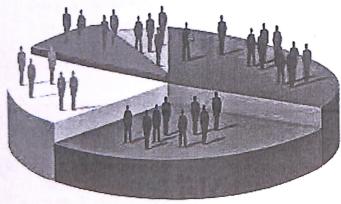

"History owes an apology to the members of LGBT Community and their familes....for the ingnominy and ostraction that they have suffered through thecenturies. The members of this community were compelled to live a life full of fear of reprisal and persecution." - said by one of the judged of the Indian Supreme Court, Justice Indu Malhotra. (Section 377 of the penal code - in criminalises consensua sexual acts between adults of same sex, was unconstitutional.)

Public opinion regarding LGBT rights in India is complex. According to a 2016 poll by the International Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Intersex Association, 35% of Indian people were in favor of legalizing same-sex marriage, with further 35% opposed. In India, this community has not been given significance. They are always looked down upon by the society. Marriage between same sex is like an intolerable situation for the country. Nonetheless, most LGBT people in India remain closeted, fearing dicrimination from their families, who might se homesexuality as shameful. Discrimination is still present in rural areas, where LGBT people often faces rejection from their families and forced opposit-sex marriages.

Now, the people of LGBT are fighting for equal rights and acceptance. Transgender espe-

cially, face a lot of difficulty in finding acceptance. This is a major issue because discrimination against the LGBT community is highly prevalent. In 1994, the Eunachs were legally granted voting rights as a thirs

sex. On 15th of April, 2014 the Supreme Court of India declared transgender people a socially and economically backward class entitiled to reservations in education and jobs, and also directed union and state governments to frame welfare schemes for them. The court also ruled out that the Indian Constitution mandates the recognition of a third gender on official documents, and that Article 15 bans discrimination based on gendr identify.

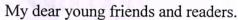

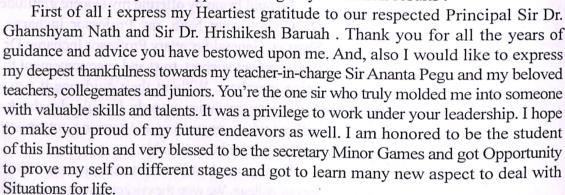
# REPORT OF THE MINOR GAMES, SECRETARY

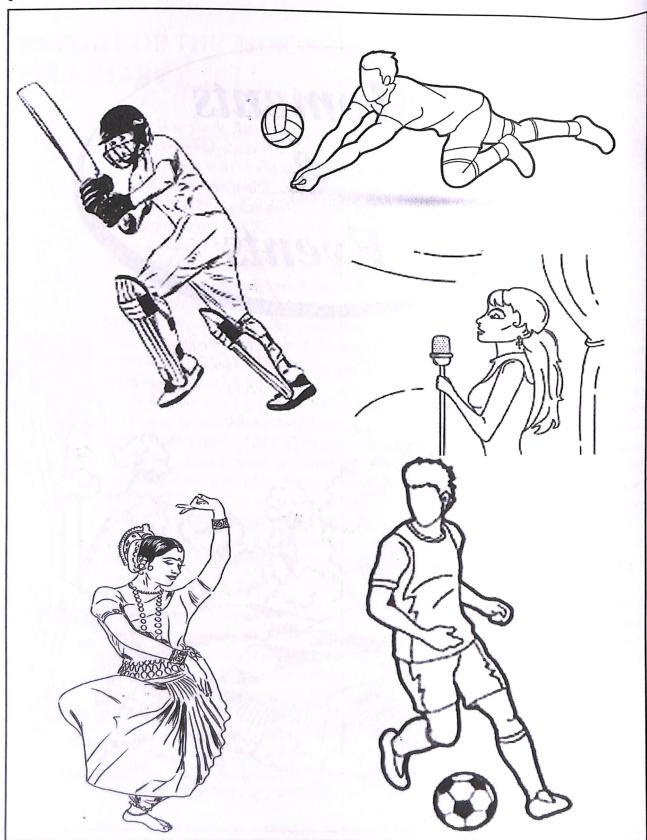

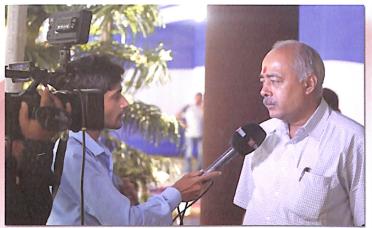

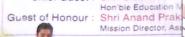
